- Weatherproof or weather-resistant (depending on model) when properly installed

BAQ series includes all the above features, plus:

- Ultra-high-intensity LEDs, 5 Vertical LED strips (26 LEDs total) for greater brightness/visibility
- 8 Different flashing patterns and adjustable duty cycle
- Adjustable flashing speed (80~260 times/min)
- Backup battery available for continuous lighting applications

SAQ series includes all features of the BAQ series, plus:

- Ultra-high-intensity LEDs, 10 Vertical LED strips (41 LEDs total) for even greater brightness
- Built-in 100dB siren (programmable)

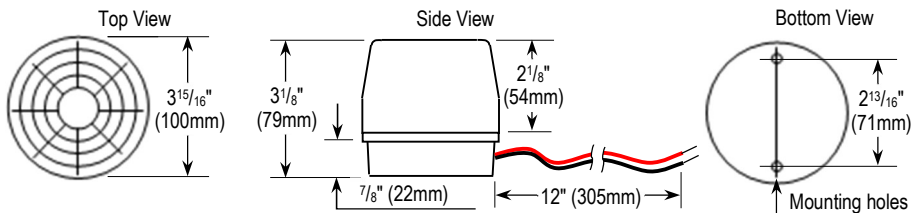

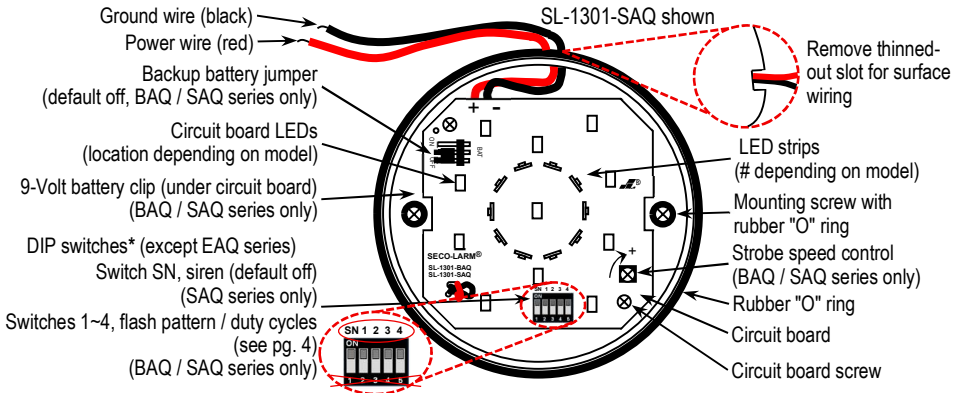

NOTE: Be sure to use the LED strobe light within the given electrical limits.

Overview



*Ignore numbers on the switch for SAQ. Use only the labels on the PCB "SN 1 2 3 4" for programming the DIP Switches.

Installation

Before starting, read the entire manual carefully and keep it for future reference.

1. Unscrew the strobe light lens and set aside.
2. For direct mounting to a flat surface:
 - a. Using the base as a template, mark the mounting and wiring holes. Drill two 1/16" (2.3mm) mounting holes.
 - b. For concealed wiring, drill a hole large enough for wires and connectors to pass through without coming loose. For surface wiring, remove the thinned-out slot with pliers (see Overview, above). Skip to step 4.
3. For mounting to ENFORCER conduit box/conduit drop (screws and gasket supplied with conduit box/drop):
 - a. Thread the wires from the conduit through the adapter plate supplied with the conduit box/drop.
 - b. Attach the plate using the short screws. Thread wires through the gasket.
4. Connect the wires, red to positive, black to negative.
5. Mount the base with the included long screws with rubber "O" rings, taking care not to crimp the wires. *If screws are fastened too tightly, the "O" rings will be damaged.* (SL-1301-EAQ series skip to step 9)
6. Select flash pattern / duty cycle with DIP Switches (see *Configuring Flash Pattern / Duty Cycle*, pg. 4). Adjust rate with the Strobe Speed Control (clockwise increases, counterclockwise decreases, see Overview above).
7. Set the siren (SL-1301-SAQ only) to on or off using DIP switch SN (default – OFF, see Overview, above).
8. If desired, install a backup battery. (See *Installing the Backup Battery*, below).
9. Replace the lens. If the lens is fastened too tightly, the "O" ring will be damaged.

Installing the Backup Battery

For continuous lighting applications, the backup battery will power the LED strobe light in the event of power loss.

1. Remove the circuit board screws and flip the circuit board over. The battery holder is attached to the back.
2. Connect a 9-volt battery (not included) to the battery connector (rechargeable batteries not supported).
3. Replace the circuit board and screws and move the backup battery jumper to the ON position.

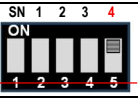
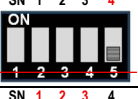
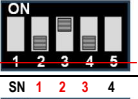
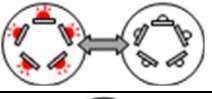
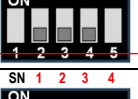

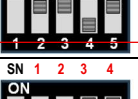

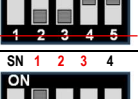

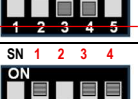



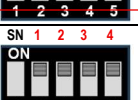
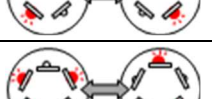
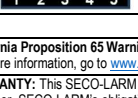
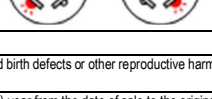
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Configuring Flash Pattern / Duty Cycle (SL-1301-BAQ / SL-1301-SAQ only)

Flash patterns and duty cycles (flash patterns 1, 2, and 5 only) are customizable. The "One-Eighth Duty Cycle" produces a sharper "strobe" more like traditional strobes. DIP Switch #4 controls the duty cycle (if supported). Visit www.seco-larm.com for a flash patterns / duty cycle demonstration.

IMPORTANT: Before changing DIP switches, disconnect power. Reconnect after setting switches.

NOTE: The numbers below refer to those on the PCB, **NOT** on the switch. The BAQ series has no SN switch.

| | DIP Switch Position | Description | Flash Pattern Top View (SL-1301-BAQ Shown) |
|---|--|--|--|
| A |  | Regular Duty Cycle LED on one-half / off one-half of each cycle (default) (Switch #4 ON, only effective for flash patterns 1, 2, and 5) | |
| B |  | One-Eighth Duty Cycle LED on one-eighth / off seven-eighths of each cycle (Switch #4 OFF, only effective for flash patterns 1, 2, and 5) | |
| 1 |  | Strobe LEDs flash on and off continuously. (default) (Switch #4 controls the duty cycle) |  |
| 2 |  | Rotate Clockwise Light rotates clockwise in a circular fashion continuously (beacon). (Switch #4 controls the duty cycle) |  |
| 3 |  | Steady ON All LEDs stay on. Ideal for continuous lighting applications. |  |
| 4 |  | Flash with Progressive ON LEDs turn on progressively clockwise until all LEDs are lit (sweep) and then turn off. |  |
| 5 |  | Rotate Back and Forth LED groups light up one at a time clockwise then counterclockwise. (Switch #4 controls the duty cycle) |  |
| 6 |  | Flash with Progressive ON/OFF LEDs turn on progressively clockwise (sweep), then turn off progressively counterclockwise. |  |
| 7 |  | Opposite Quarters Flashing Continuously LEDs in opposite quarters flash alternately, repeating continuously. |  |
| 8 |  | Opposite Quarters Flashing with Pause LEDs in opposite quarters flash alternately for 8 cycles, pause for 2 cycles, and then repeat the pattern. |  |

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
